Condon Police Department

The Condon Police Department is a one person department serving approximately 700 residents with community policing.

Job Duties

The Officer responds to call for service and assistance from citizens, patrols to deter and detect crime, investigates complaints, cites and/or arrests law and ordinance violators, follows up on pending reports and cases, and protects person and property and other duties as assigned by the Condon City Council. The Officer also has a connection with the school and assists with school and community functions (e.g., parades, dances). This position works closely with the Gilliam County Sheriff's Department.

Qualifications

Applicants must be citizens of the United States, completed high school or received a GED certification, and have appropriate and current DSSPT certification. Candidate must be of good moral character and be able to pass an extensive background investigation including a comprehensive criminal history check and credit check. Must have a minimum of 5 years' experience and possess a valid Oregon Driver's license.

Compensation

Condon employees receive health (100% paid at this time), Accidental Death & Dismemberment and Long Term Disability insurances plus PERS (100% paid). The City of Condon is in a minimum county that may allow a PERS retiree with no limits to time worked to retain current PERS benefits (please contact PERS for more information). Paid time off includes holidays designated by the City, three business days, 8 hours a month accrued vacation and 8 hours a month accrued sick leave.
