

NOTICE OF MEASURE ELECTION

CITY OF CONDON STATE OF OREGON

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, November 8, 2022 an election will be held in City of Condon, Gilliam County, Oregon. The election will be conducted by mail. The following question will be submitted to the qualified district's voters thereof:

CAPTION: Prohibits psilocybin-related businesses within the City of Condon for two (2) years. Prohibition sunsets December 31, 2024.

QUESTION: Shall the City of Condon prohibit psilocybin-related businesses in city limits?

SUMMARY: Psilocybin is the psychedelic drug found in certain mushrooms. State law allows operation and/or manufacture of certain licensed psilocybin services. State law provides that a city governing body may adopt an ordinance to be referred to the voters to prohibit (i.e., ban) the establishment and/or operation of psilocybin-related registered or licensed activities. City of Condon has adopted an ordinance to prohibit psilocybin-related businesses in the in the city limits of Condon, subject to voter approval. Approval of this measure would prohibit the establishment and/or operation of psilocybin manufacturers and/or service centers within the Condon city limits. The proposed ordinance is available for public inspection on the city's website.

Any Elector dissatisfied with the ballot title may file a petition for review in the Gilliam County Circuit Court no later than 5 p.m. on August 31, 2022. Copies of the resolution and ballot title information may be obtained from City Hall, 128 S. Main Street, Condon, Oregon 97823 during normal working hours, or available on the city's website www.cityofcondon.com.
